MINUTES OF THE MARCH 2023 BOARD MEETING

The general meeting of the Huntington Cemetery Committee (HCC) was held on Wednesday 29th March 2023 at the Community Centre on Strensall Road, Huntington at 6.00 pm.

Present: Councillor D. Geogheghan-Breen (DB), Councillor M. Duncanson (MD), Councillor A. Hawxby (AH), and Ms N. Fatima (Burial Clerk).

Apologies: Councillor C. Hillman (CH), Councillor G. Shann (GS) and Councillor J. Shann (JS)

Declaration of Interest: None

Matters Arising:

- The minutes of the last meeting dated 17th January 2023 were agreed upon and signed by the Chair.
- The accounts for Q4 2022 / 2023 were presented.

It was agreed they were a true and accurate representation of the current financial status.

- The Clerk Report detailed the Interments since the last meeting consisted of:
 - ← Cremated Remains 10
 - ← Full Burials 3

NF shared the drainage plan with the committee members.

MD will use the drainage plan to investigate if there is any blockage to alleviate the severity of flooding.

To discuss the cemetery fee increase for April 2023.

NF shared her spreadsheet (attached).

The proposal in relation to burials was a 10% increase for Non-resident rate and a 5% increase in resident rates.

The following rates will apply to all other applications;

- o Headstones £100
- Cremated Remains plaques £100
- Additional Inscription £70
- Administration fees £28
- Search fee £12

The fees were agreed upon.

Update of Burial Authority Rule 10

The committee will meet at the cemetery to draw up a plan to actively enforce Rule 10.

NF confirmed Nigel Hawking has agreed to undertake the work.

To discuss the next steps of the extension

DB will contact CH to request the paperwork in relation to the quotes received to move on to the tendering process.

Previous action points:

The burial clerk is to organise a meeting with HCC members at the Cemetery to identify the plots where personal items will be removed.

16.02.2023- The scheduled meeting at the cemetery could not take place due to a change of circumstances in HCC members' availability.

08.03.2023-The scheduled meeting was cancelled due to the snow.

Correspondence:

NF received correspondence regarding the sinking of a plot. NF contacted the gravedigger for remedial action to be taken.

Any Other Business:

- NF has been instructed to check that the address of the deceased on the cremation certificate/green certificate matches that of the application and notice of interment form to ensure the correct fees are paid by non-residents.
- After a discussion regarding Rule 6 being open to interpretation, an amendment was agreed upon.

The current rule state

6. Any application for the interment of a non-parishioner for more than 2 years at the time of death will incur non-residents charges.

6b. The above does not apply to any individual who has moved for circumstances beyond their control.

It has been agreed to amend the rule to state;

6b. The above does not apply to any individual who has moved for circumstances beyond their control. In these circumstances, the burial authority will make a decision based on individual circumstances.

AH will update the website accordingly.

 AH noted following the installation of the parking notice signs the parking during match days seems to have improved.

New action points:

Due to JS being unable to be a second authoriser on the banking system. AH has been asked to undertake the role.
