# HUNTINGTON PARISH COUNCIL - MEETING HIGHLIGHTS (21 MAY 2025)

### **CEMETERY & COMMUNITY SAFETY**

- Reports of antisocial behaviour in the cemetery have been shared with local police.
- Fly-tipping remains a concern-investigations ongoing.
- Maintenance works including ash tree assessment, weeding, and fly-tipping prevention are underway.

### **FINANCE**

- Parish bank balance: £127,333.
- Cemetery fund: £25,037.
- Approval granted for tree works and updated financial commitments, including gala costs.
- The Gala Committee received additional funding support due to vendor changes.

### **COMMUNITY SPACES**

- Orchard Park Community Centre is undergoing refurbishment and leadership changes.
- Memorial Hall and other centres shared updates.
- Plans approved to replace swings at Garth Road and replant felled trees with native oaks.



### CHURCHYARD MAINTENANCE

- Several repairs and maintenance works approved at All Saints
   Churchyard, including re-bricking compost bays, tree removal, and
   headstone safety improvements.
- The Parish Council will share costs with New Earswick where appropriate.
