A discussion was held to **Recommend** a donation be given to Orchard Park toddler morning club to assist with costs for covering breakfasts, following SJ discussing with owner of club An issue was raised with the disrepair of the path surrounding the park at Orchard Park. It was **Agreed** to **Recommend** to full parish quote be obtained from a reputable company as high priority for Health and safety reasons. Councillor **DJ** requested to ask the gardener to tackle the weeds behind the property It was agreed to put in place a risk assessment for the future Huntington Gala related events, as well as obtaining sufficient first aid cover
