42.	<p><u>Play Areas</u></p> <p>i) <u>Orchard Park</u> There have been new litter bins installed throughout the parish, however the bins also say that it is permissible to put dog waste in them as long as it is bagged. The problem is that those installed within the Play areas are becoming contentious as the parish council does not allow dogs (or dog waste) within the play areas for health and safety reasons, but now residents are challenging the caretakers at Orchard Park when asked to remove their dogs from the play areas, and residents have been seen entering the other play areas since the new bins were installed. It was agreed to ask CoYC to weld a metal plate over the 'dog bin' wording (cc KO and Cllr's Cullwick and Runciman).</p> <p>ii) <u>Vesper Way</u> It was agreed to ask Sleightholms if they hold a key for the padlock at Vesper Way, and if they do to get copies cut.</p>	LF LF
